Brains

SA Best ABV 4.2%

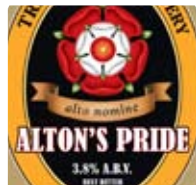
The renowned 'special ale' is copper-coloured with a full premium quality flavour. A nutty richness derived from a blend of fine Pale and Crystal malts is balanced with a satisfying dryness from the unique use of three hops: Challenger, Goldings and Fuggles. The aroma has a hint of spirit which adds to the legendary mystique of this premium cask beer.



Wychwood

Hobgoblin ABV 4.5%

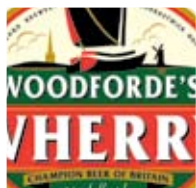
Full-bodied and well-balanced with a chocolate toffee malt flavour, moderately hoppy bitterness and a distinctive fruity character, with a ruby-red glow.



Triple FFF

Alton's Pride ABV 3.8%

After years of fine tuning, our vision for Alton's Pride is complete. A traditional amber bitter brewed using water from the Hampshire chalk hills. Full and clean-tasting, initially malty then citrus fruit and resinous hop build to a quenching bitter finish.



Woodforde's

Wherry ABV 3.8%

With a zesty aroma this is everything you could wish for from a 3.8% beer. A crisp and clean floral flavour developing into a hoppy citrus bitterness.



Timothy Taylor

Landlord ABV 4.3%

Golden in appearance with an off white head, the citrus nose carries through, well-balanced with the lingering bitterness and of course plenty of hops.



Fuller's

ESB ABV 5.5%

Bursting with cherry and orange on the nose, balanced by soft malty toffee and caramel notes. Grassy, peppery notes on the tongue along with intense citrus fruit characters of grapefruits, oranges and lemons, followed by a biscuity, toffee element to the beer. A smooth, mellow bitterness lingers on the palate to give a superbly satisfying finish.



Spitting Feathers

Basketcase ABV 4.8%

A dark ruby strong ale, rich and fruity full flavour with a smooth finish.

Spitting Feathers

Ministry of Beer False Economy ABV 3.8%

A pale beer brewed with so much hop (added at 5 different stages in the brewing process) that it probably costs the ministry more than it recovers in revenue.



Thwaites

Crafty Devil ABV 4.3%

A spicy beer for the late autumn celebrations. A fiery and spicy beer with a hint of cinnamon and cloves.



Adnams

Ghost Ship ABV 4.5%

If it had an arm the head would be tucked under one of them. Brewed with Pale Ale, Crystal, Munich and Wheat malts, Columbus, Chinook and Citra hops. A very refreshing, well-balanced beer.



J W Lees

The Governor ABV 3.8%

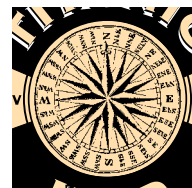
This all-malt British beer created by Marco Pierre White and J W Lees Brewery, is named after Marco's family greyhound that his father rescued. He started his racing career as Fearless, but having broken several track records was re-named The Governor. He went on to win 28 out of the 32 races that he started in Northern England. Raise your glass to The Governor and in the words of Captain Smith of the Titanic 'Be British'.



Three Tuns

Solstice ABV 3.9%

A pale straw-coloured summer beer having a light, malty quality; medium-strong, crisp, fruity bitterness with citrus and straw flavours, the character of the season.



Titanic

Mild ABV 3.5%

A mild of classic style full of roast malt and balanced by delicate hops. True to type it has a rounded sweetness and a smooth dry finish.



Liverpool Organic

Iron Men ABV 4.0%

Packed with organic New Zealand hops. A refreshing, full-bodied beer.
